Missionary Bible Institute Graduation (MBI)

The purpose for travelling to Belize (May 27 to June 3) was to be present for the Graduation ceremony of the Missionary Bible Institute that IHWN helped to plant on November 2, 2012.

During the first few days, I helped the Graduation Leader, Isamar, run errands and buy groceries for the graduation. The students fundraised \$200 (banquet food), \$150 (Monument outside the church), and \$100 (curtains, gown rentals). IHWN contributed \$180 for banquet food, cake, and decorations.

Rewarding experiences included helping the graduates decorate the church the day before grad, and
